"There's a season for everything and a time for every matter under the heavens."

Ecclesiastes 3:1 (CEB)

By many accounts, Solomon was one of the wisest people who ever lived. He experienced many things seeking answers to the questions and doubts which filled him. His writings communicate a "been there, done that" view. And while you can get a sense of disillusionment from some of his writings - "all is vanity" (1:2), Solomon always returned to God.

Solomon's writings are beautiful poetry. They speak to the eternal dichotomy of life. We might say opposites attract. When we know joy, sorrow may linger, too. Where we have hope, resignation may be nearby. While we are filled with love, apathy can raise its head. This is the way of mortal life, a cycle we all know.

Thankfully, faith enters the picture. Solomon also wrote, "God has made everything fitting in its time, but has also placed eternity in their hearts" (v11). And then he goes on to say we should enjoy ourselves and do what is good while we live.

We don't have to succumb to the monotony of life. There's more to life than sound bites, fads, or the latest crisis. When we look at the world with eyes of faith, we see the good, lovely and beautiful around us. We know love through the people with us. We see God's hand at work. And this gives us hope.

God's grace is like a safety net, making good things happen. We may not be sure why they happen, but we can appreciate it when they do. I believe God constantly sends us divine reminders: we aren't alone. God is with us!

I'm excited about this new year and the new season we are in. I feel God's presence is with PUMC, guiding us and inviting us to participate. We have experienced the bittersweetness of life. Let's now experience



some of its sweetness as we walk together.

 γ he Leadership Council believes refocusing on nurture, missions, and worship & witness can

rejuvenate us and help us make disciples. They've been exploring ways we can reorganize so each member of our congregation can be supported in what God calls them to do.

We introduced the idea to the congregation at our Open House in September and again at our All Church Gathering in October. And our District Superintendent, Rev. Moonyoung Lee, has approved our proposal.

The next step is to develop a plan to help Placentia UMC be best positioned to serve our community now and in the future. We envision a two-part process. One part will be to engage with you, the people of our congregation, as we explore some questions together:

If you are interested in helping with this initiative, please speak with Pastor Eric or a Leadership Council member. We set the timeline. It's important to do this seasonal work right, not fast. We will communicate what we learn and where we are as we go, through the newsletter and other means.
